The Food for Learning program was started at Elizabeth Rummel School in the fall of 2001 in response to concerns raised by staff that a number of our students were regularly arriving at school hungry and with inadequate lunches. The purpose of the program is to provide a daily nutritious lunch for students who participate in the program. Last year, Lawrence Grassi School also began to offer the Food for Learning Program.

Families refer their children to the program. There are no criteria to qualify. All referrals are accepted. This year there are 11 students at each school receiving daily lunches.

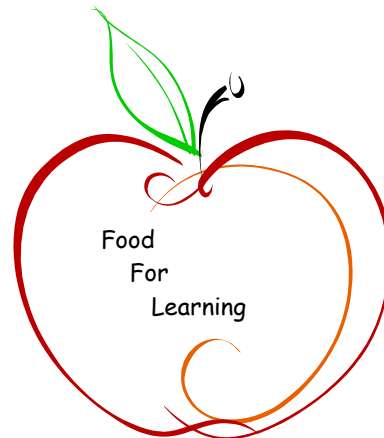
We have noticed that students who receive the lunches appear happier and healthier. In many cases, attendance at school improves once the child begins the Food for Learning program. Teachers have reported changes in behaviour for children who were experiencing difficulty socializing with their peers. These students are more able to concentrate.

The cost for the program is about \$600/student for the year. The success of the program depends entirely on the generosity and support of individuals, local businesses and community groups. We have also applied for and received grants from the Canadian Living Breakfast for Learning Foundation. School Councils at both schools sponsor the students to participate in the Hot Lunch and Pizza Days. We appreciate the work of our dedicated volunteers who help with the preparation and distribution of the lunches.
